USE EMERGENCY ROOM FOR EMERGENCIES

It is important to remember that the emergency room is for emergencies only. Emergency situations can be categorized as severe or painful conditions that — if not treated immediately — can result in loss of life or limb.

So remember, in the event of a severe or life-threatening condition, call 9-1-1 or visit the nearest Emergency Room.

WHEN TO CALL 9-1-1:

If you think you or someone you know is having a heart attack or stroke, call 9-1-1 immediately. Do not drive to the hospital. By calling 9-1-1 at the first sign of symptoms, you buy yourself time. Plus, you give emergency medical personnel the opportunity to start care on-site and en route to the hospital.

ALWAYS CALL 9-1-1 IF:

- The person's condition seems life threatening or could get worse on the way to the hospital
- Moving the person might cause further injury
- You can't get to the emergency department quickly

Allergies


Severe earaches

Poisoning
